



### **TFO Prodigy Cultural Arts Program String Instructor Job Description**

Part-time, seasonal

May 29, 2018-July 27, 2018, possible extension

The Florida Orchestra seeks to hire a beginning strings instructor to work with the Prodigy Cultural Arts Program with the Florida Orchestra during June and July 2018. The Strings Instructor will help develop and deliver a strings programs in high poverty areas of Tampa in partnership with the University Area Community Development Corporation's (UACDC) Prodigy Cultural Arts Program. In addition to teaching beginning strings classes to children ages 5-19, the program will focus on developing social justice programs within the music discipline. The Strings Instructor will work 15-20 hours per week, and may be expected to attend events outside of the 9am-5pm work day. Schedule is flexible and mutually agreed-upon between instructor and UACDC. May work some weekends.

#### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Attend the UACDC social justice training and complete all orientation requirements.
- Advise on purchase of equipment for classes.
- Assist in recruitment of students to classes.
- In partnership with TFO Community Engagement Director, plan and develop curriculum and program schedule.
- Deliver all beginning strings instruction for students ages 5-19.
- In coordination with TFO's Community Engagement Coordinator, provide all required reports and measures of student progress to UACDC.
- Make recommendations for continuation of the strings program into the 2018-2019 school year.

#### **Qualifications**

- Accomplished string player
- Interest in helping to build an excellent educational string programs
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent experience
- Must be qualified to live and eligible to work in the United States as of December 1, 2017
- Must own or have access to a vehicle and have valid driver's license
- Must complete a criminal background check upon accepting the position

Job Type: Part-time, maximum of 20 hours per week

This is a temporary position, with potential for continuation into the 2018-2019 school year
