



### **TFO Prodigy Cultural Arts Program String Instructor Job Description**

The Florida Orchestra seeks to hire beginning strings instructors to work with the Prodigy Cultural Arts Program. The Strings Instructor will help develop and deliver a strings programs in high poverty areas of Tampa in partnership with the University Area Community Development Corporation's (UACDC) Prodigy Cultural Arts Program. In addition to teaching beginning strings classes to children ages 5-19, the program will focus on developing social justice programs within the music discipline. Classes meet 3 hours per week, generally after school during the week. Number of classes assigned is dependent upon program recruitment and capacity. May work some weekends.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

- Attend the UACDC social justice training and complete all orientation requirements.
- Advise on purchase on equipment for classes.
- Assist in recruitment of students to classes.
- In partnership with TFO Community Engagement Coordinator, plan and develop curriculum and program schedule.
- Deliver all beginning strings instruction for students ages 5-19.
- In coordination with TFO's Community Engagement Coordinator, provide all required reports and measures of student progress to UACDC.

### **Qualifications**

- Accomplished string player
- One year of teaching experience
- Interest in helping to build an excellent educational string program
- Must be qualified to live and eligible to work in the United States
- Must own or have access to a vehicle and have valid driver's license
- Must complete a criminal background check upon accepting the position
